

## **NLF Reading Challenge 2021: Junior Readers**

### **Terms of the Challenge**

- This Reading Challenge is designed to get children to read more, reflect on and discuss their reading, and connect with other readers like themselves
  
- A **Reading Schedule** is shared at the start of the Challenge in **January 2021** to help the participants navigate their reading
  
- There are 2 Tracks for the Challenge: the **Competitive** and the **Non-Competitive** Track
  
- Readers who wish to pursue the **Non-Competitive Track** may read the books on the list, participate in the activities, and the Book Chats that are shared on our social media pages. They soak in the reading experience!
  
- School Librarians or Coordinators will pick students to form teams to enrol in the **Competitive Track**. Each team will have 4 members. It is recommended that each team has students from a mix of age groups as the books on the reading list span across an age band.
  
- Each team in the Competitive Track is expected to read **3 books every week**. These students also maintain a **Reading Log** that is updated regularly. The School Librarian or Coordinator will be responsible for ensuring that the teams keep up with the Reading Schedule.
  
- Teams on the Competitive Track respond to the **prompts** that are announced on our social media pages **every 2 weeks**. These would include book talks; Flipgrid activities; designing alternative book covers, and so on.
  
- Participants are also a part of the Book Chats on Zoom every month.
  
- At the conclusion of the challenge in June 2021, the teams compete in an online quiz based on their reading of the books. The best three teams win Gold, Silver, and Bronze engraved trophies; certificates of achievement, and a set of great books each!
